The Fees Commission to resume public hearings in Pretoria

The Commission of Inquiry into Higher Education and Training (Fees Commission) will resume with public hearings into the feasibility of a fee-free higher education on Thursday, 22 September 2016.

The hearings will present the Commission with an opportunity to complete its Set 1 programme that was suspended due to disruptions by some student groupings.

Presentations that were scheduled for Kimberley and Bloemfontein will now be heard in Pretoria.

Focus is still on the overview of the relevant issues that form part of the series of hearings that will be held with various identified stakeholders.
