REMUNERATION OF MAGISTRATES

- 1 In terms of section 12(1) of the Magistrates Act, 1993, (Act No.90 of 1993), I hereby determine that, the remuneration and allowances of the positions of office bearers in Column 3 of Schedule 1 shall be as set out in Column 4 of Schedule 1 with effect from 01 April 2013, subject to terms and conditions set out herein.

- 2 The total remuneration shall include the following elements:
 - 2.1. A basic salary component equal to 70% of the total package, which constitutes the pensionable salary;
 - 2.2. pension benefit contribution to the applicable pension fund; and
 - 2.3. A Flexible portion for the remaining amount of the total package.

3. Proclamation No.6, published in the Government Gazette No. 36283 of 22 March 2013, is hereby repealed.
