PROCLAMATION NOTICE 70 OF 2022



DETERMINATION OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF MAGISTRATES

1. In terms of section 12(1) of the Magistrates Act, 1993 (Act No. 90 of 1993) (hereafter referred to as "the Act"), I hereby determine that the remuneration of the magistrates shall be as set out in the Schedule with effect from 01 April 2021, subject to the terms and conditions set out herein.
2. The total remuneration packages shall include the following elements:
 - 2.1 A basic salary component equal to 70% of the total package, which constitutes the pensionable salary;
 - 2.2 Pension benefit contribution to the applicable pension fund; and
 - 2.3 A flexible portion for the remaining amount of the total remuneration.
