**AMENDMENT TO THE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE COMMISSION OF
INQUIRY INTO ALLEGATIONS OF STATE CAPTURE, CORRUPTION AND
FRAUD IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR INCLUDING ORGANS OF STATE**

I hereby, under section 1 of the Commissions Act, 1947 (Act No. 8 of 1947), and by means of the accompanying Proclamation amend the Terms of Reference of the Commission of Inquiry into allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Sector including Organs of State extend the Commission's term from 15 November 2022 to 15 January 2023 to enable it to complete such administrative tasks as indicated in the attached Schedule.

Definition

1. In this Proclamation "Terms of Reference" means the terms of reference published under Proclamation No. 3 of 2018 in published in the Government Gazette No. 41403 of 2 January 2018 as amended by Proclamations No. 34 of 2018, No. 18 of 2020, No. 12 of 2021 and No. 31 of 2021, No 46 of 2021, No 64 of 2022, No 68 of 2022 and No 91 of 2022.

Amendment of the Terms of Reference

2. The Terms of Reference is hereby amended by the substitution of paragraph five (5) of the following paragraph:

"5. **[The Commission shall submit its report and recommendations to the President by 15 June 2022].** Notwithstanding the delivery by the Commission of the final part of its report to the President, the Commission's term of office is hereby extended from 15 November 2022 to 15 January 2023 to enable the Commission to perform such

administrative functions as may be required to be performed before the Commission ceases to exist.
