JUSTICE DEPARTMENT TO HOST A JUSTICE SERVICES FAIR AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT IN NYANGA, CAPE TOWN

The Department of Justice and Constitutional Development (DOJ&CD) will host a community engagement and justice service fair to local communities in and around Nyanga, Western Cape.

The initiative takes place as part of the Department's celebration of the 25th anniversary of the Constitution and a central focus will be on promoting awareness of Constitutional rights.
