### National Action Plan to Combat Racism, Racial Discrimination, Xenophobia and Related Intolerance

The Department of Justice and Constitutional Development (DoJ&CD) in collaboration with the Human Sciences Research Council (HSRC) invites you to a multi-stakeholder webinar to discuss **Anti-immigrant sentiments in the current South African context**.

The inputs from this webinar will contribute towards developing recommendations and a policy brief on dealing with xenophobic attacks in the context of the National Action Plan to combat Racism, Racial Discrimination, Xenophobia and Related Intolerance (NAP) approved by Cabinet on 27 February 2019.
